
Stage 2 Light Rail Transit Update

Stage 2 Benefits

- Stage 2 will add:
 - 44 km of rail;
 - 24 stations;
 - 45 vehicles; and,
 - 2 additional maintenance and storage facilities;
- The total economic output from the project is approximately \$5.6 billion (2018\$) and over 27 thousand person-years of employment; and,
- With Stage 2 completed, the City's O-Train network will bring 77% of Ottawa residents within 5 km of fast, efficient, clean and reliable light rail service.

O-Train South Extension



Airport Link

- Topsoil removal and capping with gravel along the alignment;
- Installation of ditches and culverts along the line underway;
 and,
- Utilities investigations around structures for the elevated guideway at the Airport continues.







New Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF)

 The main track at the existing Walkley Yard MSF was shifted to make room for the footprint of the new MSF building.





South Extension Upcoming Activities

- Caisson drilling for rail bridges;
- Utility relocation along Airport link;
- Rail delivery begins; and,
- New MSF building foundation works.


Stadler Vehicles

- The Stage 2 O-Train South vehicle contract included a number of requirements for the new Diesel Multiple Unit (DMU) vehicles, including, but not limited to:
 - Tier IV Final Emissions Standards (latest EPA standard);
 - Increased door count for efficient passenger flow as compared to the previous and existing vehicles;
 - Operating range of -40C to +40C degrees; and,
 - 35 year lifespan with conversion to electric possible.



O-Train East and West Extensions





- Site office construction at Woodroffe Avenue and Baseline Road;
- Sir John A. Macdonald (SJAM) Parkway works:
 - Initial SJAM detour in place;
 - Multi-Use Pathway (MUP) widening complete;
 - Stripping, grubbing, proof rolling complete; and,
 - Continuing construction for road realignment.
- Borehole investigation target of mid-October for completion; and,
- Pre-construction surveys of site and buildings ongoing.







Upcoming East & West Activities

Fall 2019:

- Tree clearing along the full alignment;
- OR 174 widening begins;
- Montreal bridges and flyover preparatory works;
- Utility works near Kitchissippi Lookout, Richmond Road and OR 174;
- Carling Avenue bridge rehabilitation; and,
- Pinecrest Creek culvert.
