 - Customers with accessibility devices.



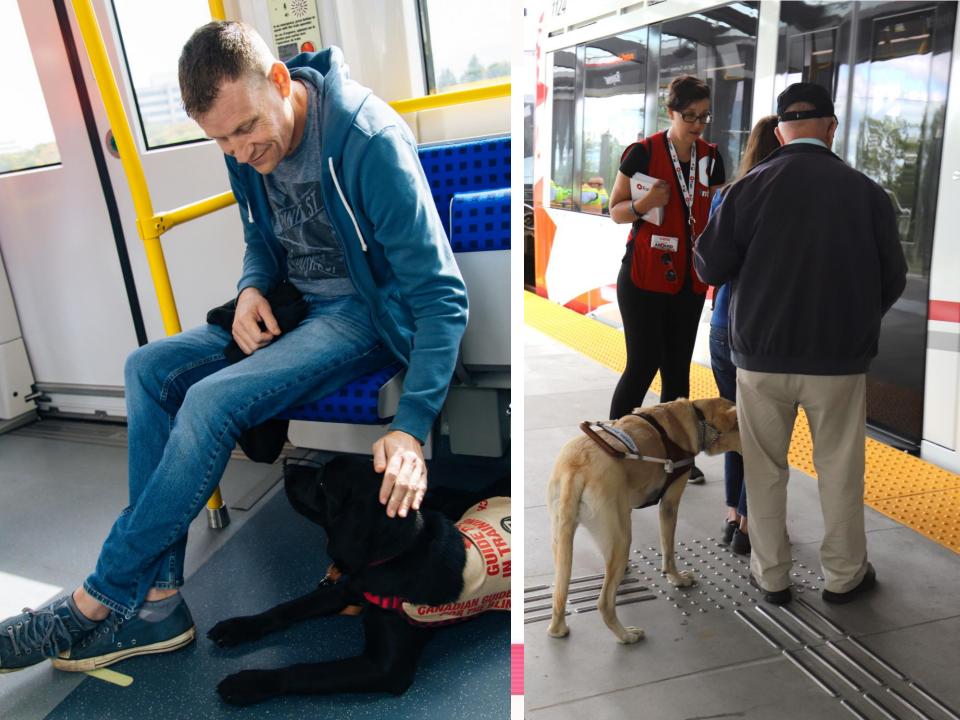


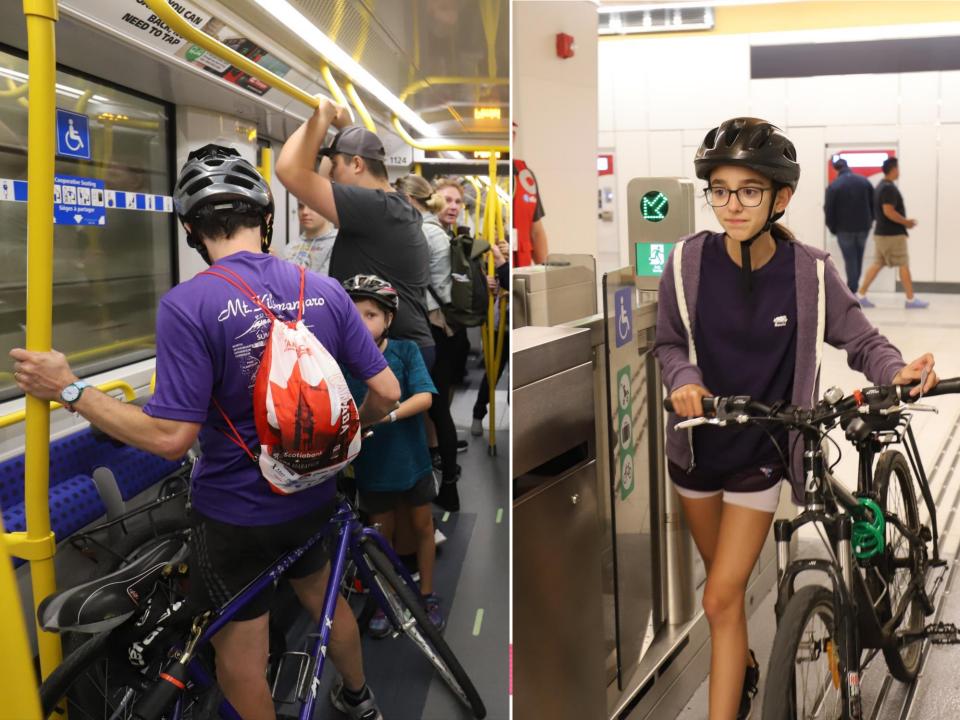














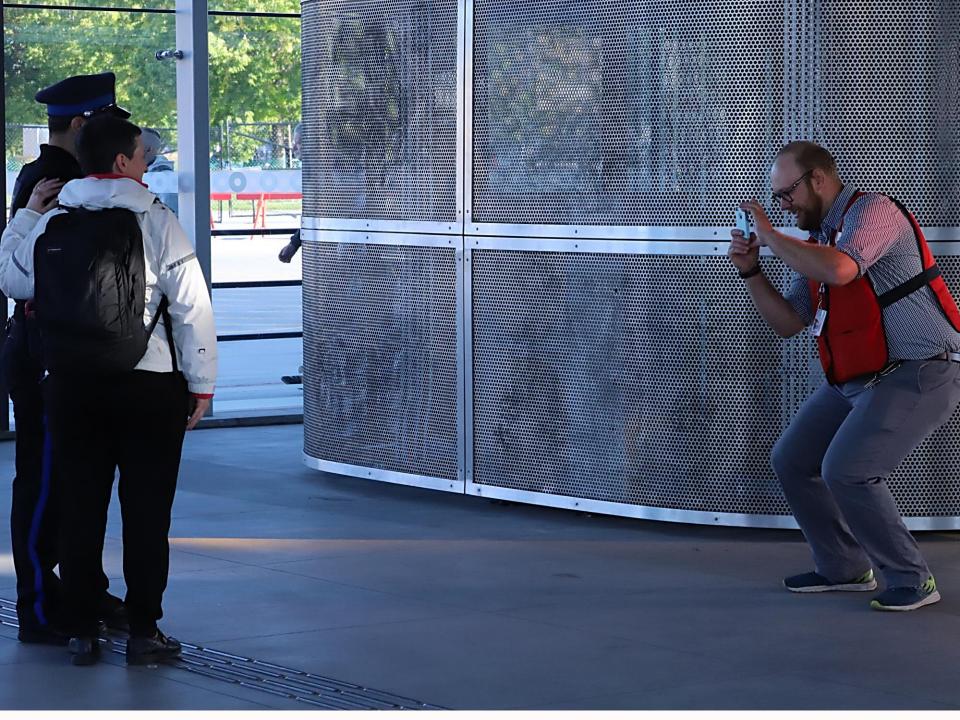

Summary of Service

Saturday and Sunday

- Very successful launch of the O-Train Confederation Line on Saturday;
- Sunday was a busy day with many customers riding the trains and exploring the stations from end to end;
- The system ran well and we welcomed thousands of customers onto the line with many positive reports on social media, etc.;
- The Sunday morning launch was on time and the morning commute ran very well without incident or delays; and,
- No serious incidents or service delays:
 - Minor issues with escalators and elevators; and,
 - Minor interruption with the video chat function on the ticket machines.

Summary of Service (cont'd)

Monday

- Morning launch was on time and the commute ran without incident or delays;
- 8-minute service delay during afternoon peak, which was addressed quickly by the Electric Rail Operator;
- Monitoring train to bus connections for the thousands of customers on the line;
- There will continue to be a period of adjustment for our customers; and,
- Our support plan, that includes O-Train Ambassadors in the red vests, and outreach continues to assist customers with our new multimodal service.

Moving Forward

- OC Transpo staff and O-Train Ambassadors (OTAs) will continue to help customers navigate the system;
- Parallel bus service will continue to October 5;
- Service change on Sunday, October 6, will be the next key date; and,
- Staff are tracking all ideas and feedback, and the list is being prioritized.
